The law with reference to harassment is set forth in the Maine Revised Statutes Annotated, Title 17-A, amended as follows;

Sec. 506-A Harassment

Sec. 1. A person is guilty of harassment if, without reasonable cause, he engaged in any course of conduct with the intent to harass, torment or threaten another person, after having been forbidden to do so by any sheriff, deputy sheriff, constable police officer or justice of the peace.

Sec. 2. Harassment is a Class E Crime.

A Class E Crime is designated as a crime in which the imprisonment penalty does not exceed six months. The maximum fine for a Class E Crime shall not exceed \$1,000.00.

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
